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Engineer David Hook and Mike Hughes met with the board to discuss the following:

- FEMA – All of first round applications for 35 sites have been submitted which includes force account and work to be completed. An estimated \$2.2 million on the initial application which is subject to FEMA’s final review and approval.
- ODOT Safety Improvements Grants – approximately \$50,000.00 for sign upgrades for the “Retroreflectivity” mandatory replacement. Federal highway may delay it due to the expense. The county will be gradually replacing the signs to be compliant.
- ODOT Safety Study Grant for software replacement estimated at \$2,000.00 -\$1800.00 ODOT share with \$200.00 county match.
- Jaybird Phase II – property acquisitions are completed.
- Jaybird Phase I – railroad property acquisition
- Coon Hill Road Bridge - should be completed soon.
- Straight Creek Bridge- will be opened early spring.

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The Adams County Local Soil & Water Board met with the commissioners to submit the updated 2012 Local Soil & Water District budget. Manager Allan Cluxton and board members Jack Hazelbaker, Chester Grooms, and Richard Dryden discussed health insurance for employees, state match, and other counties that have passed levies for funding. The commissioners complemented the board on their programs and staff administration.
