**PROCLAMATION CHILD ABUSE & NEGLECT PREVENTION AWARENESS MONTH:
RESOLUTION NO. 2019-148**

It was moved by Diane Ward and seconded by Barbara Moore to proclaim the month of April as Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Awareness Month in Adams County.

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect are a serious problem affecting every segment of our community, and finding solutions requires input and action from everyone in our community; and

WHEREAS, our children are our most valuable resources and will shape the future of our community and state; and

WHEREAS, every 30 minutes, one child is abused or neglected in Ohio. Child abuse can have long-term psychological, emotional, and physical effects that can have lifelong consequences for victims of abuse; and

WHEREAS, research has shown that when protective factors including: parental resiliency; social connection; knowledge of parenting and child development; concrete support; and social and emotional development, are present the incidence of child abuse and neglect is reduced; and,

WHEREAS, effective child abuse prevention activities succeed because of the meaningful connections and partnerships created between child welfare, education, health, community- and faith-based organizations, businesses and law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, we know that 87% of adults across America believe that child abuse and child neglect is a preventable problem; most just do not know how they can help. We acknowledge that we must work together as a community to increase awareness about child abuse and contribute to promote the social and emotional well-being of children and families in a safe, stable, nurturing environment; and

WHEREAS, Adams County Children Services received 515 reports of child abuse/neglect in 2018. Prevention remains the best defense for our children and families.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the Adams County Commissioners, do hereby proclaim April 2019 as CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT PREVENTION MONTH in Adams County, Ohio, and urge all citizens to recognize this month by dedicating ourselves to the task of improving the quality of life for all children and families. Together, let us work toward ‘Strong and Thriving Families.’ Take time to become a mentor or a foster parent, to help children in need!

Whereas, Sexual Assault Awareness Month is intended to draw attention to the fact that sexual violence is widespread and impacts every community member of Adams County and

Whereas, every 92 seconds an American is sexually assaulted. Every 9 minutes, that victim is a child. Meanwhile only 5 out of every 1,000 perpetrators end up in prison; and (DOJ 2017)

Whereas, One in 9 girls and 1 in 53 boys under the age of 18 experience sexual abuse or assault at the hands of an adult; and (RAINN 2014)
