RESOLUTION NO. 2018-138**

It was moved by Diane Ward and seconded by Brian Baldrige to proclaim the month of April 2018 as Sexual Assault Awareness Month in Adams County as follows:

SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS MONTH PROCLAMATION

Whereas, Sexual Assault Awareness Month is intended to draw attention to the fact that sexual violence is widespread and impacts every community member of Adams County and

Whereas, Child sexual abuse prevention must be a priority to confront the reality that one in six boys and one in four girls will experience a sexual assault before the age 18 (Dube et al., 2005).; and

Whereas, young people experience heightened rates of sexual violence, and youth ages 12-17 were 2 times as likely to be victims of rape or sexual assault (Snyder & Sickmund, 2006).; and

Whereas, we must work together to educate our community about sexual violence prevention, supporting survivors, and speaking out against harmful attitudes and actions; and

Whereas, With leadership, dedication, and encouragement, there is evidence that we can be successful in preventing sexual violence in Adams County through increased education, awareness, and community involvement; and

Whereas, The Adams County Board of Commissioners strongly supports the efforts of national, state, and local partners, and of every citizen, to actively engage in public and private efforts to prevent sexual violence. It’s time for all of us to start conversations, take appropriate action and support one another to create a safer environment for all.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That We, The Adams County Board of Commissioners, join advocates and communities across the country in playing an active role to prevent sexual violence. Along with the United States Government and State of Ohio, we do hereby proclaim April as “Sexual Assault Awareness Month”! Hereby we set our Hand on the 2nd day of April 2018.
