The following letter was prepared to be presented to the Adams County Flying Club at their upcoming meeting which addressed various issues including airport fuel sales:
June 5, 2017

Re: Airport Fuel Tanks & Water Service

Dear Adams County Flying Club Members:

It has been discovered that the location of the underground fuel storage tanks for the Adams County Airport are not on county property and are in fact located on the property of the Flying Club. Therefore, upon the advice of legal counsel and the Ohio State Fire Marshall’s office, the county is no longer responsible for filing the mandatory certification of the underground storage tanks with “OTTER”, Ohio Tank Tracking & Environmental Regulations, as required by “BUSTR, Bureau of Underground Storage Tank Regulation, due to the ownership of the property. The Ohio State Fire Marshall’s office has informed the board that the Flying Club must file ownership, all documentation and certification with the Fire Marshall’s office by June 30, 2017. The county is not interested in a transfer of ownership of the property from the Flying Club, on which the tanks are located. It is the opinion of the board that this situation will now enable the Flying Club to have full and complete control of fuel purchases and establishment of fuel prices in the future without the cumbersome authority of the county regulating the purchase and sale of fuel. This transition of fuel operations from the county to the Flying Club will ensure fuel availability and monitoring as the county does not currently have an employee that is assigned this task.

It has also been brought to the attention of the Adams County Commissioners that the Flying Club’s water supply is connected to the county’s tap line and must be removed immediately upon the advice of legal counsel.

Legal counsel has informed the board that both situations are not “proper public purpose” and the county is not liable. Providing public funds for private purpose is a violation and must cease immediately. However, the Adams County Board of Commissioners has agreed to assist with the removal and transfer of the fuel pump system from county property and will also assist with the cost of the mandated update for the fuel card reader. Providing the water tap for the Flying Club is not the responsibility of the county. The Flying Club will need to contact the Adams County Regional Water District for installation of a water tap.
