WHEREAS, drunk driving crashes on our nation's roads killed an average of 10,000 people from 2010-2014; and

WHEREAS, 40% of motor vehicle fatalities across the United States during the 2014 Labor Day weekend were alcohol-related, which was the highest percentage over the past five years; and

WHEREAS, an enforcement crackdown is planned to combat impaired driving; and

WHEREAS, the Labor Day Holiday Season in particular is traditionally time of social gatherings which include alcohol; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, Ohio Traffic Safety Office, and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration has asked law enforcement agencies throughout Ohio to

participate in the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over 2016 Labor Day Holiday Statewide Crackdown*; and

WHEREAS, the project will involve increased impaired driving enforcement from August 19 through September 5, 2016; and

WHEREAS, an increase in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving will save lives on our roadways;
